

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (F.Y.B.TECH-2021-22)

### Q. 1. What is the eligibility for getting admission for F.Y.B. Tech. in Vishwakarma Institute of Technology?

Ans: The admission of **F.Y B. Tech.** students in Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune

#### **(A) For Maharashtra State candidate**

- (i) Passed HSC or its equivalent examination with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one of the Chemistry or Biotechnology or Biology or Technical or Vocational subjects, and obtained at least **45% marks** (at least **40% marks**, in case of Backward class categories and Persons with Disability candidates belonging to Maharashtra State only) in the above subjects Or taken together;
- (ii) Passed Diploma in Engineering and Technology and obtained at least **45% marks** (at least **40% marks**, in case of Backward class categories and Persons with Disability candidates or belonging to Maharashtra State only);
- (iii) Obtained **non zero score** in **MHT-CET 2021** conducted by the Competent Authority.

#### **(B) All India Candidature Candidates, Jammu and Kashmir Migrant Candidates**

- (i) The Candidate should be an Indian National;
- (ii) Passed HSC or its equivalent examination with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one of the Chemistry or Biotechnology or Biology or Technical or Vocational subjects and obtained at least **45% marks** (at least **40% marks**, in case of Backward class categories and Persons with Disability candidates belonging to Maharashtra State only) Or in the above subjects taken together;
- (iii) Passed Diploma in Engineering and Technology and obtained at least **45% marks** (at least **40% marks**, in case of Backward class categories and Persons with Disability candidates Or belonging to Maharashtra State only);
- (iv) Obtained **non zero score** in **MHT-CET 2021** or have obtained **non zero positive score** in **JEE 2021 Main Paper I**.

### Q. 2. Is it possible to get admission for B. Tech. in Vishwakarma Institute of Technology without appearing CET or JEE?

Ans. NO. It is mandatory for a student to score in MHT-CET 2021 or JEE 2021 Main Paper I to get admission in Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune and **registering and securing merit number through State CET Cell procedure is mandatory.**

### Q. 3. Does Vishwakarma Institute of Technology conduct its own entrance examination for admissions?

Ans: No. Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune does not conduct its own entrance examination. Admissions are given strictly according to the rules of State Govt of Maharashtra, DTE Maharashtra, ARA Maharashtra and State CET Cell Maharashtra State

#### **Q.5 How VIT, Pune has taken up the Challenge of COVID 19 pandemic in terms of Academics?**

##### **1. Steps taken in the Last Academic Year:-**

Since January 2020, the whole world started going through very challenging phase due to COVID 19 pandemic. Hence, this was really a tough time for the people from all fields and education field is not also an exception for it. However, through the strong support of its management, pioneering vision of Honorable Director along with the entire team of VIT has taken up this challenge positively.

At VIT, Pune we strongly believe that unprecedented time calls for bold moves. In the month of March 2020, the sudden closure (lockdown) of Colleges, University Campus was declared due to COVID 19 pandemic and that gave rise to serious issue of teaching learning of students. However, VIT overcame this issue by immediately switching over to full-fledged Online Teaching Learning mode through its own Vishwakarma Online Learning Platform (VOLP) So, even though our buildings were empty our classes remained full with online Teaching Learning via VOLP. Thus by using our own online educational platforms (VOLP) and Vishwakarma Institutes Enterprise Resource Planning (VIERP) we continued the teaching learning as well as the evaluation processes with immense rigor.

##### **2. Online teaching learning:-**

Over the years, VIT, Pune has already envisioned the importance of online mode of teaching learning and had taken appropriate measures for the use of digital technology as a tool to augment visualization and interactivity. These efforts have resulted in the successful development of its own indigenous cloud -based platform Vishwakarma Online Learning Platform (VOLP) as well as Vishwakarma Institutes Enterprise Resource Planning (VIERP). At VIT, Pune, the undergraduate level, post graduate level as well as the research scholars are facilitated with various Virtual Labs thereby helping them in learning basic and advanced concepts through remote experimentation thereby inculcating self-learning ability. In addition the Virtual Labs avail students with the various tools for learning, including additional web-resources, video-lectures, animated demonstrations and self-evaluation.

##### **3. Planning and Execution for the Academic Year 2021-2022**

In view of academic year 2021-2022, we at VIT, Pune, with the latest technology aided teaching-learning pedagogy and a team of well-trained faculties have already ensured effective planning of various activities like Syllabus completion, Assessment and Examination along with Mentoring and Support Systems. **Q.6 Owing to COVID 19 pandemic, at VIT Pune what measures are taken to ensure Health safety and social distancing?**

**1. Health safety as the Top priority:**

In present COVID19 pandemic situation, we at VIT gives top priority to the health and safety of our staff as well as our students.

**2. Implementation of Safety and social Distancing Norms:-**

At VIT Pune we are regularly practicing all the mandatory safety, hygiene and social distancing, norms stringently as prescribed by the Health Ministry of India as well as the state/local government. **Q. 7. How does application process works?**

Ans:

1. The candidates should apply online on [www.mahacet.org](http://www.mahacet.org) as per schedule.
2. Filling the Online Application Form for admission through their login which is provided to them at the time of applying to the Common Entrance Test conducted for that course. Candidates aspiring for admission on the basis of JEE 2021 (Main) Paper 1 (who could not register for MHT-CET 2021 should apply, by paying required fees, through CAP under All India Seats or to be eligible for admission under Institutional Quota seats.
3. The candidate should fill the Online Application Form by reading carefully the Information Brochure.
4. After filling the information and submission of Application Form, the Candidates shall verify the data filled and correct it if required. The candidate shall take printout of the form and sign it.
5. This is followed by the confirmation of Online Application Form and Document Verification at Facilitation Centre by the Candidate in person.
6. Display or Publishing of Provisional merit list, Submission of grievances, if any, and Display or Publishing of Final Merit Lists
7. Online Submission & Confirmation of Option Form of CAP rounds
8. Reporting to the Admission Reporting Centre (ARC) as per Allotment of CAP Round

9. Reporting to the Allotted Institute and Confirmation of Admission by submitting required documents and payment of fee after CAP Round

**Q.8. What is seats distribution for any branch in Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune?**

**Ans:** The distribution of seats for any branch/course in Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune is: (1) State level seats through MHT-CET – 85% of intake, (2) All India seats through JEE Advanced – 15% of intake,

**Ans:-** VIT Pune, has **NO** institute level Seats.

**Q. 12. How quality education is guaranteed in Vishwakarma Institute of Technology?**

**Ans.** Accrediting bodies like National Assessment & Accreditation Council (NAAC) and National Board of Accreditation (NBA) both constituted by UGC and MHRD look after and assesses the quality of education delivered by the Institute. Vishwakarma Institute of Technology has received accreditation from both and remains to continue for the same in future.

**Q. 13. How is Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune B. Tech. Program designed?**

**Ans :** At Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune, a choice based credit system with continuous evaluation is followed in semester pattern.

**Q. 14. Is branch transfer possible after joining the B. Tech. program in anyone of the B. Tech. program in Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune?**

Ans : **No.** There is no provision for branch transfer in Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune.

**Q. 15. Are there any seats reserved for foreign nationals? How they are filled?**

Ans: **Yes.** There are 15% seats over and above the sanction intake are reserved for foreign nationals and are filled as per the procedure laid down by State Govt of Maharashtra and competent authorities.

**Q.16. Is fee structure same for NRI/NRI sponsored/foreign nationals?**

Ans: **No.** Fees structure is different for foreign nationals and is decided by Fees Regulating Authority, Maharashtra state. Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune abides to their rules.

**Q. 17. Can NRI/Foreign nationals pay fee in currency of their respective countries?**

Ans: No. The fee is to be paid in India Rupees only.

**Q. 18. Does Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune assist in campus placements?**

Ans: **Yes,** every year 120+ companies visit to our campus for recruitment. Average placement percentage is 85% every year.

**Q. 19. Are hostel facilities available at Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune?**

Ans: Although Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune does not have residential campus, but provides limited hostel facilities to students. Hostels are located merely in the range of 2-3 Km from Institute. Preference is given to first year students for hostel admissions on first come first serve basis. Contact details to hostel warden are given on Institute website or one may get details by communicating in students section of the Institute or from the admissions counseling cell whose numbers are displayed on website. Food facility is available in all hostels.

**Q.20. Is separate hostel facilities provided to girls?**

Ans: **Yes.** Girls are provided with separate hostel facilities. Food facility is also available.

**Q. 24. How to reach Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune?**

Ans: Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune is located within Pune city. The campus is accessible by public as well as private transport facilities. Pune municipal corporation buses operate from different parts of the city to Upper Indira Nagar (Upper Depot). Frequent buses are available from Swargate depot to reach VIT, Pune campus. One has to alight at Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune stop to reach to campus. Complete campus address is available on institute website.
